The Complainant, Sumina B. Quill, respectfully represents to the Court as follows:-

FIRST: That the Complainant and the Respondent were married in the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland, on the 8th day of August, 1907, by the Rev. Josiah Dixon, a regularly ordained Minister of the Gospel of the Methodist Church.
