TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Your Oratrix complaining respectfully says:-

I. That she went through an alleged marriage ceremony with one Joseph Boyd on the 6th day of January, 1921 and with whom she resided until about the 27th day of September, 1925.

(2) Your Oratrix always conducted herself as a faithful, chaste and affectionate wife.

(3) That the defendant, Joseph Boyd, had at the time of the marriage to your Oratrix, a living wife by a prior marriage, Eva Boyd of Raleigh, North Carolina, from whom he had not been divorced, and that the said Eva Boyd, first wife of the defendant, is now residing at 408 South St., Raleigh, North Carolina.

(4) That your Oratrix has not lived or co-habited with the defendant since she discovered the prior marriage.

(5) Your Oratrix is destitute and without the proper funds to prosecute this suit and she is advised by counsel that she may petition this Honorable Court that she may be granted a reasonable sum as alimony pendente lite for the support of herself and counsel fee to compensate her solicitors. The defendant is employed and earns about thirty dollars per week.

WHEREFORE YOUR PETITIONER PRAYS:

- (a) That her marriage to Joseph Boyd be annulled.
- (b) That she may resume her maiden name, Warren.
- (c) That she may have such other and further relief as her case may require.

May it please your Honor to grant unto your Oratrix the writ of subpoena directed against the said Joseph Boyd, commanding and requiring him to be and appear in this Court on some day certain to be named therein to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree or order as may be passed therein.
