King is convict AND WHEREAS, the said judgment has been duly recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore City, in Liber S.C.L. No. 117 folio 5 one of the Records for Judgment obtained before a Justice of the Peace for Baltimore City. THEREFORE YOU ARE HEREBY COMMANDED TO ATTACH any of the lands, tenements, goods, chattels and credits of the said John C. King if they should be found in your bailiwick, to the value of the damages, costs, and charges aforesaid, and when you have the same so attached, or any part thereof, the same in your custody shall safe keep, so that you have the same before the Superior Court to be held at the Court House in the City of Baltimore on the second Monday of July next, then and there to be condemned according to the Acts of Assembly in such case made and provided, to and for the use of the said....
