The Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of the City of Baltimore, do on their oath present that ALBERT JONES late of said City, on the twelfth day of March in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty one at the City aforesaid. unlawfully at a certain boarding house of one Ida Charity then and there being ~~to wit, the~~, did receive and cause to be furnished to him, the said ALBERT JONES certain food and accomodation of the value of forty dollars current money, and did then and there fraudulently fail to pay for the same, contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided, and against the peace, government and dignity of the State.


SECOND COUNT.

And the Jurors aforesaid, upon their oath aforesaid, do further present that the said ALBERT JONES on the said day in the said year, at the City aforesaid, at a certain boarding house of one Ida Charity, then and there being, ~~to wit, the~~, unlawfully fraudulently did then and there obtain from the said Ida Charity, certain credit of the value of Forty dollars current money, by the use of a certain false pretence and device then and there made to the said Ida Charity, and by fraudulently depositing at said boarding house certain baggage and property of value less than the amount of said credit and of the bill by him the said ALBERT JONES at the said boarding house incurred, contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided, and against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

THIRD COUNT.

And the Jurors aforesaid, upon their oath aforesaid, do further present that the said ALBERT JONES on the said day in the said year, at the City aforesaid, having previously obtained there at a certain boarding house of Ida Charity then and there being, ~~to wit, the~~ certain credit and accomodation of the value of Forty dollars current money, unlawfully did abscond and fraudulently depart and remove his baggage therefrom without discharging the debt as aforesaid incurred, contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided, and against the peace, government and dignity of the State.


