THEREFORE YOUR ORATRIX PRAYS:

a-a A divorce A Vinculo Matrimonii from the respondent.

b-b Such other and further relief as the case may require.

May it please Your Honor to grant unto your oratrix  
a writ of subpoena, directed unto the said respondent, command-  
ing him to be or appear in this court on some day certain to be  
named therein, to perform such decree as may be passed in the  
premises.
