George Gracey, by his attorneys, Davis and Evans, sues Luther Heath for that on or about the 1st day of June, 1927, while the plaintiff was riding in an automobile at the intersection of Greenmount Avenue and 25th street, both public highways of Baltimore City, State of Maryland, the automobile in which the plaintiff was riding was struck by an automobile driven by Luther Heath as a result of the reckless and negligent manner that the defendant, Luther Heath operated his automobile.

That the plaintiff, as a result of the defendant's having negligently and recklessly operated his automobile, was seriously injured about his head, limbs and body and remained so for a long time; to wit: from thence, hitherto, during all of which time he was forced to and did spend large sums of money in attempting to cure himself of his hurts and wounds occasioned aforesaid.

And the plaintiff says that all of his aforesaid injuries and damages were caused by the negligence, carelessness and want of due care on the part of the defendant, his servants, agents or employees or either of them and that he was guilty of no negligence contributing thereto.

WHEREFORE the plaintiff claims \$10,000 damages.
