late of said city, on the.....**first**..... day of.....**May**....., in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and.....**twenty-eight**....., at the City aforesaid, in violation of a certain ordinance of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore theretofore duly enacted and ordained, to wit:.....

Section one hundred and twenty-nine of Article forty-eight
of the Baltimore City Code of the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and ninety-three, as repealed and re-enacted with amendments by Ordinance number One of the **said** Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, passed and approved on the twenty-fourth day of July, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and nineteen, unlawfully did shoot off and discharge a certain pistol within the limits of the said City, **he**, the said **CHARLES FELDMAN**, not then and there so firing the said pistol on any occasion of military parade, **by** order of any officer having the command thereof,

against the form of the ordinance in such case made and provided, and against the peace, government and dignity of the State.
