The Jurors of the State of Maryland, for the body of the City of Baltimore do on their oath present that WINFIELD BORDLEY and WILLIAM JACKSONday of September fourth late of said City, on the, in the year of twenty-eight our Lord nineteen hundred and....., at the City aforesaid by a certain false pretense by each of them then and there made to one Barbara Schepf, (which said false pretense was not then and there a mere promise for future payment, and was not then and there a mere promise for future payment not intended to be performed) unlawfully, knowingly and designedly did attempt to obtain from the said Barbara Schepf certain goods, moneys and properties of the said Barbara Schepf, to wit, one suitcase of the value of twenty-one dollars and fifty cents current money, with intent then and there to defraud the said Barbara Schepf; and in furtherance of said attempt did then and there falsely pretend that the husband of the said Barbara Schepf, to wit, James Schepf, had there and then and theretofore told the said WINFIELD BORDLEY to call at the home of the said James Schepf, there to obtain the said suitcase for and on behalf of the said James Schepf, all of which said representations were then and there false, fraudulent and untrue, and were known by the said WINFIELD BORDLEY and WILLIAM JACKSON to be then and there false, fraudulent and untrue, against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

SECOND COUNT.

And the Jurors aforesaid, upon their oath aforesaid, do further present that the said WINFIELD BORDLEY and WILLIAM JACKSON, on the fourth day of September, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-eight, at the City aforesaid, unlawfully did conspire, combine, confederate and agree together, and with each other, by divers false pretenses and representations, and other false and subtle means and devices, to obtain and acquire unto themselves certain goods, chattels, moneys and properties of Barbara Schepf, then and there being, and to cheat and defraud the said Barbara Schepf thereof; against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

THIRD COUNT.
