City aforesaid, in and upon one Helen Pearson
who was then and there a woman child, under the age of fourteen years, feloniously did make an assault and her, the said
Helen Pearson then and there feloniously did carnally know
and abuse, contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided and against the peace, government
and dignity of the State.

FOURTH COUNT.

And the Jurors aforesaid, upon their oath aforesaid, do further present that the said
JAMES WALKER on the said day in the said year at the City aforesaid, in and upon one Helen Pearson
who was then and there a woman child under the age of fourteen years, unlawfully did make an assault and her, the said
Helen Pearson did then and there beat, with intent then and there, her, the said
Helen Pearson feloniously to carnally know and
abuse, contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided and against the peace, government and
dignity of the State.

FIFTH COUNT.

And the Jurors aforesaid, upon their oath aforesaid, do further present that the said
JAMES WALKER on the said day in the said year at the City aforesaid,
in and upon a certain female, not his wife, to wit, Helen Pearson
who was then and there between the ages of fourteen and sixteen years, unlawfully did make an assault and her the said
Helen Pearson did then and there carnally know, contrary to the form
of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided and against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

SIXTH COUNT.

And the Jurors aforesaid, upon their oath aforesaid, do further present that the said
JAMES WALKER on the said day in the said year at the City aforesaid, in and upon one Helen Pearson
unlawfully did make an assault and her, the said Helen Pearson did then and
there beat, against the peace, government and dignity of the State.
