Louis Brown by his attorneys, Davis and Evans, sues the Consolidated Gas Electric Light and Power Company of Baltimore City, a body corporate.

1. For that the Consolidated Gas Electric Light and Power Company of Baltimore City is a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Maryland and doing business in Baltimore City.

2. For that heretofore, to wit: on or about the 28th day of May, 1923 the plaintiff's son, Elmer Brown, an infant, was struck by an automobile of the defendant at or near to the intersection of Monument street with another certain street known as Bond street, both public streets of Baltimore City, at or near to their intersection; the said automobile of the defendant being then and there under the care, control and management of the then servants of the defendant, their servants, agents and employees.

3. And the defendant, whose duty it was to cause said automobile to be driven with great care, caution and diligence, did, by its servants, then and there so carelessly and negligently drive said automobile that it ran into and struck against the said Elmer Brown, infant, with great force and violence and he was then and there hurt and wounded and he became and was sick, sore and lame and so remained for a long time, during all of which time the plaintiff was deprived of the services of his

son, the said Elmer Brown, for a long time, to wit: from thence hitherto. And the plaintiff was forced to and did spend divers sums of money in endeavoring to cure his son of his hurts and wounds occasioned as aforesaid.

AND the plaintiff says that the injuries of Elmer Brown, infant and the plaintiff's damages suffered therefrom were caused by reason of the negligence, carelessness and want of due care on the part of the defendant, its servants, agents and employees and not through any negligence on the part of the plaintiff or Elmer Brown contributing directly thereto.

WHEREFORE the plaintiff claims \$5000.00 damages.
