Louis Brown, father and next ffiend of Elmer Brown, infant, by Davis and Evans his attorneys, sues the Consolidated Gas, Electric Light and Power Company of Baltimore City, a body corporate.

- I. For that the Consolidated Gas, Electric Light and Power Company of Baltimore City, is a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Maryland and doing business in Baltimore City.
- 2. For that whereas, the plaintiff to wit, on the 28th day of May, I923 was struck by an automobile of the defendants at or near to the intersection of Monument Street with another certain street known as Bond Street at their intersection. And the said automobile of the defendant was then and there under the care, controll and management of the then servants of the defendant, their servants, agents and employees, and the defendant whose duty it was to cause said automobile to be driven with great care caution and diligence, did by its servants then and there so catelessly and negligently drive said automobile that it ran into and struck against said Elmer Brown with great force and violence and he was then and there hurt and wounded and he became and was sick, sore and lame and so remained for a long time, during all of which time he was prevented from performing his ordinary affairs.

3. And the plaintiff says that the said Elmer Brown's injuries and damages were caused by reason of the negligence and carelessness and want of due care on the part of the defendant and not through any negligence on his part contributing directly thereto.

WHEREFORE the plaintiff claims \$5,000.00 damages.
