For that heretofore, to wit, on or about the 17th day of December, 1924 while the plaintiff was lawfully crossing a public highway at or near the corner of Pennsylvania Avenue and Presstman Street, both public highways of the City of Baltimore, he was run into by an automobile operated by the defendant and as a result thereof was seriously and permanently injured about the head, limbs and body and was caused to suffer great pain and mental anguish and was put to great expense for hospital and medical services and was deprived for a long period of performing his usual occupation.

And the plaintiff further says that all of his aforesaid injuries and damages were occasioned by the negligence of the defendant and that he in nowise contributed thereto.




