Christine Chambers, by her attorneys, Davis and Evans, sues John Yoffee and Nathan Walpert, for that on or about the 29th day of June, 1926 while the plaintiff was legally crossing a public highway in the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland at the intersection of Division and Laurens Streets, both public highways in Baltimore City, State of Maryland, she was struck by the automobile of John Yoffee as a result of reckless and negligent manner that the defendants, John Yoffee and Nathan Walpert, or either of them, operated their automobile.

The plaintiff says that as a result of the defendants having negligently and recklessly operated their automobile, she was thrown down against the street with great force and violence and she was seriously injured about her head, limbs and body and she became and was sick, sore, lame and disordered and remained so for a long time, to wit; from thence, hitherto, during all of which time she was forced to and did spend large sums of money in attempting to cure herself of her hurts and wounds occasioned aforesaid, and was prevented from following her usual duties.

And the plaintiff says that all of her aforesaid injuries and damages were caused by the negligence, carelessness and want of due care on the part of the defendants or either of them, their servants, agents or employees or either of them, and that she was guilty of no negligence contributing thereto.

WHEREFORE the plaintiff claims \$10,000 damages.
