Doris A. Mineburg, an infant, by Frederick F. Mineburg, her father and next friend, by Edwin H. Brownley, their Attorney, sue Joseph T. H. Rochester, the defendant.

For that heretofore, to wit, on or about the 18th day of April 1926, the infant plaintiff was riding in an automobile driven by her father, said Frederick F. Mineburg, south on Wolfe Street, at its intersection with Gay Street, both of said streets being public highways of Baltimore City, in the State of Maryland, and that while being so driven, and exercising due care, the said automobile in which the infant plaintiff was riding, was struck with great force by an automobile which was then and there being carelessly and negligently driven and operated by the defendant at a high and reckless rate of speed, and that as a direct result of the carelessness and negligence of the said defendant, the automobile in which the infant plaintiff was riding was struck by the defendant automobile as aforesaid, and as a result of said collision, said infant plaintiff was thrown from said automobile to the ground, in consequence whereof she was severely bruised and lacerated about the body, head and neck and permanently injured, in consequence of which the said infant plaintiff was caused to suffer great physical pain and mental anguish and was confined to a hospital for a long period of time.

And the plaintiffs say that the said accident and injuries to the infant plaintiff were solely caused by the negligence and want of care on the part of the defendant in the premises, and without any negligence or want of care on the part of the infant


plaintiff contributing thereto.

Wherefore this suit is brought, and the plaintiffs claim Five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) damages.
