And the plaintiffs say that the said accident and injuries to the infant plaintiff were solely caused by the negligence and want of care on the part of the defendant in the premises, and without any negligence or want of care on the part of the infant plaintiff contributing thereto.

Wherefore this suit is brought, and the plaintiffs claim Five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) damages.


