TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Your Orator complaining respectfully represents:

(1) That he was married to his wife, Sallie Dutton, on or about the day of 19 and with whom he resided until about the day of 19

(2) That though the conduct of your Orator toward the said Sallie Dutton has always been kind, affectionate and above reproach, she has, without just cause or reason abandoned and deserted him and has declared her intention to live with him no longer, and that such abandonment has continued uninterruptedly for more than three years and is deliberate and final, and the separation of the parties is beyond any reasonable expectation of reconciliation.

(3) That your Orator has not lived or co-habited with the said defendant since said desertion.

(4) That there are no children as issue of said marriage.

(5) That both your Orator and the defendant are citizens of the State of Maryland, having resided in Baltimore City for more than three years prior to the filing of this bill of complaint.

TO THE END, THEREFORE:

(a) That your Orator may be divorced a Vinculo Matrimonii from the said Sallie Dutton.

(b) That he may have such other and further relief as his case may require.

May it please your Honor to grant unto your Orator the Writ of Subpoena directed against the said Sallie Dutton, commanding and requiring her to be and appear in this Court on some day certain to be named therein to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree or order as may be passed therein.
