Whereas, William C. Elliott brought before me, the subscriber, a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland, in and for the Prince George County, aforesaid; charged on the oath of Rebecca Elliott with having on or about the 12th day of May, 1924, and on divers other times did "Beat and Strike her, using profane and abusive language, and did orderly conduct" and having his right waived to jury trial, was thereupon, on this 15th day of May, 1924, tried before me and found guilty, of said offense and sentenced to the MARYLAND HOUSE OF CORRECTION, for the space of one (1) year, from date hereof, or he be discharged in due course of law.

You are hereby commanded to receive the said William Elliott, into your custody, in the Maryland House Of Correction and him safely keep.
