2. That said alleged will was not executed by said Amelia Biddle when she was of sound and disposing mind and capable of executing a valid deed or contract.


3. That the said Amelia Biddle was an uneducated person and unable to read or write, and that at the time of the execution of the said alleged will, she did not understand or know the contents thereof.


