The petition of Maggie Miller and Ada Harris, legatees under the Will of the late Cornelia Anderson, respectfully presents:-

1. That Abraham L. Gaines, Executor under the Will of the late Cornelia Anderson, filed his first and final account within this Court on or about the *14* day of *July*, 1925.
2. That at the time of the filing of the account the Executor credited himself along with other things, an item "Monument and perpetual care of cemetery lot" two hundred and fifty (\$250.00) dollars.
3. That there is and was at the time of the filing of the account a monument on the lot.
4. That the Executor failed to account for certain monies collected by him for the estate, to wit:- fifty (\$50.00) dollars from the Nazarites; thirty-six (\$36.60) dollars and sixty cents from the Mutual Benefit Society of Baltimore City.
