TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

1. That on or about the 30th day of August, 1924, the said Benice McKinney was appointed guardian of the estate of William Robinson, Jr., infant.

2. That the sole estate of William Robinson, Jr. (infant) consists of ~~the sum of \$1215.46~~ <sup>\$1215.46</sup> received from the estate of Susie Robinson (Franklin) deceased.

3. That the said Benice McKinney has had the care and custody of the said William Robinson, Jr., infant, since Aug. 30, 1924; and that she has received no funds or aid either from the estate of the aforementioned Susie Robinson (Franklin), deceased or any other source towards the support of the said William Robinson, Jr., infant.

4. That the said Benice McKinney has expended from her private funds the following amounts for the following purposes:

Board from Aug. 30, 1924 to Aug. 1, 1925 at \$5.00 per week in advance, 48 weeks.....	\$240.00
Clothing from Aug. 30, 1924 to Aug. 1, 1925.....	40.00

That this Honorable Court will pass an order allowing her <sup>#</sup>317<sup>31</sup> with which to reimburse herself for the amounts that she has already expended on account of the support of William Robinson, Jr., infant.
