COMMITMENT TO MARYLAND HOUSE OF CORRECTION.

STATE OF MARYLAND, WORCESTER COUNTY, to-wit:-

To the Superintendent of the Maryland House of Correction, Greeting

WHEREAS, Clarence Fletcher, was before me, the subscriber, a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland, in and for the County aforesaid, and being informed by me of his right to trial by jury, freely elected to be tried by me, the subscriber, and a jury trial not being prayed on the part of the State of Maryland, by the State's Attorney, was this 22nd, day of March, 1924, duly tried upon the charge of, on information and oath of Otis Manuel, that the said Clarence Fletcher, on the 18th day of March, 1924 near Stockton, Worcester Co., aforesaid, did "Wear and Carry concealed on or about his person a certain deadly weapon, viz., a Pistol, said Clarence Fletcher not being thus and a then a conservative of the peace entitled or required to carry such weapons as a reasonable precaution against apprehended danger or not being an officer of some other State temporarily sojourning in this State or a railroad official" of which offense he was by me found guilty and I therefore gave judgment and sentence that the said Clarence Fletcher for his offense should be imprisoned in the Maryland House of Correction twenty-four (24) months.

This is therefore to command you to receive the said Clarence Fletcher into your custody in said Maryland House of Correction, there to imprison him for the said space of 24 months, and for so doing this shall be your sufficient warrant.
