Frederick F. Mineburg, Plaintiff, by Edwin H. Brownley, his Attorney sues Joseph T. H. Rochester, the Defendant.

For that heretofore, to wit, on or about the 18th day of April, 1926, the plaintiff was lawfully and prudently driving his automobile south on Wolfe Street, at its intersection with Gay Street, both of which said streets are public highways of the City of Baltimore and State of Maryland, and that while he was so driving and exercising due care and caution, the plaintiff's said automobile was struck with great force by an automobile which was then and there being carelessly and negligently driven and operated by the defendant, at a high and reckless rate of speed, and that as a direct result of the carelessness and negligence of the said defendant, the plaintiff's automobile was struck as aforesaid, injuring and damaging said plaintiff's automobile, so as to make it unfit for use and beyond reasonable repair, and that the plaintiff has been deprived of the use of his said automobile for a long period of time, and has been otherwise injured and damaged.

And the plaintiff says that the damages for which he sues were directly caused by the negligence and want of care of the defendant, and without negligence or want of care on the part of the plaintiff, directly contributing thereto.

Wherefore, this suit is brought, and the plaintiff claims Five hundred dollars (\$500.00) damages.
