TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Your Oratrix complaining respectfully represents:-

FIRST: That the said Elizabeth Green is the daughter of the said Richard P. Green, deceased and the said Elizabeth Green on the 8th day of March, 1922, was appointed Executrix of the estate of said Richard P. Green.

SECOND: That the said Richard P. Green had an account with the Savings Bank of Baltimore, a corporation situated in the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland.

THIRD: That the name of the co-defendant, Mary Sanks appears on the said account of Richard P. Green as survivor.

FOURTH: That the money deposited in the aforesaid bank in the name of Richard P. Green and the aforesaid Mary Sanks represents the money of the said Richard P. Green and that no part of it represents the savings or money of the aforesaid Mary Sanks.

FIFTH: That during the life of the aforesaid Richard P. Green the bank book always remained in the possession of the aforesaid Richard P. Green and that the name of the aforesaid Mary Sanks was only placed on the bank book of the aforesaid Richard P. Green as a matter of convenience, that is to say, that if the aforesaid Richard P. Green, deceased, was every incapacitated,

the said Richard P. Green could withdraw his money by the said Mary Sanks, said money withdrawn to be for the sole use of Richard P. Green.

SIXTH: That the relation between the said Richard P. Green was solely that as between a lodger and the proprietress of a lodging house, that is to say, that the said Richard P. Green maintained a room at the residence of the aforesaid Mary Sanks. That there was no other relation whatsoever.

SEVENTH: That the defendant, Mary Sanks, has expressed a desire to withdraw the funds from the defendant bank for her purpose, and that if the defendant does so withdraw the said funds, irreparable injury will be done the heirs of the aforesaid Richard P. Green, deceased.

EIGHTH: Unless the Honorable Court will intervene to prevent this action on the part of the defendant, Mary Sanks, the just claim and right of the heirs to the property of Richard P. Green will be without redress.

WHEREFORE your Oratrix prays:


I. That your Honorable Court direct a Writ of Injunction or a restraining order enjoining and restraining the withdrawal of the money, now in the name of Richard P. Green, deceased and Mary Sanks from The Savings Bank of Baltimore, until further order of this Court, from paying any money, to the said Mary Sanks deposited in the name of Richard P. Green and Mary Sanks

2. That the said bank account in the Savings Bank of Baltimore in the name of Richard P. Green, deceased, be declared the sole property of the said Richard P. Green deceased, and that the money to the credit of the said account be declared a part of the estate of the said Richard P. Green.

Such other and further relief as this case may require.

3. May it please your Honor to grant unto your Oratrix a Writ of Subpoena directed unto the defendant Mary Sanks and the defendent, The Savings Bank of Baltimore, commanding them to be and appear in this Court on some day certain to be named therein to answer such decrees as may be passed in the premises.



Green and Mary Sanks" or in the name of Mary Sanks, or unto any person in behalf of Mary Sanks. *until the filing of the answer of the said Mary Sanks to the bill of complaint filed in this case, and the further order of the court.*

And further, That the said Mary Sanks is hereby enjoined and restrained from withdrawing, disposing of or assigning or transferring any part or portion of said money now in name of "Richard P. Green and Mary Sanks" or any money received by reason of transfer of said account in the name of "Richard P. Green or Mary Sanks" *until the filing of her answer and the further order of the court* in The Savings Bank of Baltimore, unless cause to the contrary be shown on or before the *27th* day of
