Frances Hawkins, plaintiff, by Arthur R. Padgett, his Attorney, sues Eldridge Jones, Defendant.

(1) For that the defendant is the father of an infant child, Bernice Jones, and as such father is and always has been liable for her maintenance, support and education; that the plaintiff is the mother-in-law of the said defendant and the grandmother of said infant child; that the said plaintiff has supported and maintained said infant child since its birth eleven years ago and the said defendant has utterly failed and neglected to contribute anything towards the support of said infant child, though requested so to do; that the said plaintiff has expended large sums of money for the maintenance and education of said infant child and she has demanded the payment of such sums from the said defendant but the said defendant has refused to pay same, although he is and has been fully able to pay for the maintenance and support of said child; that the said defendant is liable to the plaintiff for the support of said child during all of said time and that the amounts expended by the plaintiff were for necessaries reasonably suited to the needs and conditions of said child.

(2) And for money payable by the defendant to the plaintiff for money paid by the plaintiff for the defendant at his request as per the account annexed hereto as a part hereof.

WHEREFORE this suit is brought and the plaintiff claims Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) damages.
