

Nancy Hill, by her attorneys Davis and Evans sues The Yellow Cab Company, a corporation, for that on or about January 16, 1925 the defendant corporation was a common carrier of passengers by gasoline propelled vehicles, to wit, taxi-cabs, in the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland.

That on said day the plaintiff was accepted as and became a passenger in one of the cabs of the defendant corporation; that while she was such passenger, at the Union Station, City of Baltimore, the door of the said Cab was closed negligently by the defendant's servant; whereby the plaintiff was greatly injured and her right hand and fingers of her right hand were greatly injured; and that the plaintiff was guilty of no negligence contributing thereto.

WHEREFORE the plaintiff claims therefore \$2500.00.
