William Johnson by his attorneys, Davis and Evans, sue s
Austin Breckenridge:

1. For that the plaintiff, to wit: on the 28th day of June 1924 at Baltimore City, in the State of Maryland, was walking along and upon a certain street or highway known as Franklin Street at or near to its intersection with another certain street or highway known as Green street, at their intersection.
2. And the said defendant was operating his automobile near to the crossing or intersection of said Green street with Franklin street as aforesaid, and while the plaintiff with due care for his own safety, was then and there crossing said Green street at the crossing aforesaid, the defendant, whose duty it was to cause said automobile to approach, pass or turn in said Franklin street at said intersection or crossing there with great care, caution and diligence, did then and there, so carelessly and negligently cause said automobile to be driven to and over said intersection or crossing; that said automobile ran into and struck against said plaintiff with great force and violence, and thereby the said plaintiff was thrown down with such great force and violence unto and against the pavement of said street, that he was then and there hurt and wounded and he became and was sick, sore and lame and disordered and so remained for a long time, to wit: from thence, hitherto, during all of which time the said plaintiff suffered great pain and was hindered from performing his ordinary affairs and business.

3. And the plaintiff says that his injuries and damages were caused by reason of the negligence and carelessness and want of due care on the part of the defendant and not through any negligence on his part contributing directly thereto.

WHEREFORE the plaintiff claims \$5,000.00 damages.
