Bertha Johnson by her attorneys, Davis and Evans sues the Star Life Insurance Company of America, a corporation, incorporated for the issuance of policies of insurance upon the lives of persons, for that on or about the 16th day of June, 1926 the said Star Life Insurance Company issued policy No. I06I520 on the life of Lovenia Gaines, the amount of benefit for natural death being three hundred dollars; that the plaintiff Bertha Johnson was designated beneficiary in said policy; that on or about the 12th day of September, 1927 the said Lovenia Gaines died at Towson, Maryland; that the said policy was in benefit at the time of the death of the said Lovenia Gaines; that the beneficiary, Bertha Johnson has since the death of the said Lovenia Gaines, made repeated demands upon the defendant corporation for the payment of the said benefit, three hundred dollars, due under policy No. I06I520, issued by the Star Life Insurance Company of Maryland on the life of the said Lovenia Gaines, deceased and that the said defendant corporation has refused and still refuses to pay the same.

WHEREFORE the plaintiff claims four hundred dollars.
