Ella Johnson, plaintiff, by her attorneys, Davis and Evans  
sues the United Railways and Electric Company, a body corporate.

For that heretofore, to wit: at the time of the happen-  
ing of the accident hereinafter referred to the defendant company  
was and still is a common carrier of passengers by means of elec-  
trically propelled cars, or motor cars over the streets of Balti-  
more City.

That on or about the 1st day of October, 1926 the plain-  
tiff was injured as a result of the premature starting of a car  
on which she was a passenger; said car being then and there under  
the care and control of the then servants, agents or employees of  
the defendant Company, and as a result was thrown down into and  
against the street and divers bones in her body were broken and  
she became and was sick, sore, lame and disordered and so remained  
for a long time, to wit: from thence, hitherto, during all of  
which time she was prevented from performing her usual duties  
and following her usual occupation and was forced to and did spend  
divers sums of money in attempting to cure herself of her hurts  
and wounds occasioned as aforesaid.

And the plaintiff says that all of her injuries and  
damages were caused by the carelessness, negligence and want of  
due care on the part of the defendant company, its servants, agents  
or employees or either of them and that she in no wise contributed  
thereto.

WHEREFORE suit is brought and the plaintiff claims  
\$5000.00 damages.


