COMMITMENT TO THE MARYLAND HOUSE OF CORRECTION

STATE OF MARYLAND; CITY OF BALTIMORE, to-wit:

To the Superintendent of the Maryland House of Correction, Greeting:

WHEREAS, John L. Jones hereinafter called the Traverser, after having been informed by me of his right to have a trial by jury of the charge hereinafter mentioned preferred against the said Traverser on the oath of Emma Jones and having thereupon declared that he wished to waive his said right to a trial by jury and abide by the determination of the said charge by me, and the States Attorney for the City of Baltimore not having before the trial of the said offense prayed a jury trial on behalf of the State of Maryland, was thereupon, on this 17th day of June, 1921, duly tried before me, the undersigned, a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland in and for the City aforesaid, duly selected to sit at the Northwestern Police Station House upon the charge of, and was thereupon, on said trial, found guilty of the offense

Assaulting and striking Emma Jones

on or about the 17th day of June, 1921, in Baltimore City, State of Maryland, and it was thereupon adjudged that the said Traverser for the said offense should be imprisoned in the Maryland House of Correction for the space of three(3) months from the date hereof.

Now, THEREFORE, You are hereby commanded to receive from any officer the body of the said Traverser and him safely keep in the said Maryland House of Correction until the said Traverser shall be thence delivered according to law.
