COMMITMENT TO THE MARYLAND OF CORRECTION,

To the Superintendent of the Maryland House of Correction, Greeting:-

WHEREAS, Isaac Lewis was before me, the subscriber, a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland in and for the County aforesaid, and being informed by me of his right to trial by jury, freely elected to be tried by me, the subscriber, and a jury trial not being prayed on the part of the State of Maryland, by the States Attorney, was this ...14th..dayof September 1921 duly tried upon the charge, on information and oath of Granville Cropper that the said Isaac Lewis on the.. 14th day of September 1921 at Ocean City Worcester County aforesaid, did pick the pocket of Granville Cropper of which offense he was by me found guilty, and I therefore gave Judgement and Sentence that the said Isaac Lewis for his ... offense should be imprisoned in the Maryland House of Correction for the space of twelve months.

This is therefore to command you to receive the said Isaac Lewis into your custody in said Maryland House of Correction, there to imprison him for the said space of months, and for so doing this shall be your sufficient warrant.
