Macy McKinnon, plaintiff, by Davis and Evans, her attorney
sues Dr. Maxwell L. Mazer and Fannie Mazer, defendants.

For that on the 21st day of October, 1927, the defendants
procured the arrest of the plaintiff on the charge of larceny of
a watch and some clothes of the defendants; that the plaintiff
was brought before Justice Thomas F. O'Neill, one of the police
Justices of Baltimore City for the north^{WESTERN} district, and in con-
sequence of the false testimony of the defendants, the plaintiff
was committed for the action of the Grand Jury; that the de-
fendants appeared before the Grand Jury and charged the plaintiff
with having committed the aforesaid crime, in consequence of
which the said Grand Jury found a true bill against the plaintiff
and she was held for trial at the September term of the Criminal
Court of Baltimore City, and was tried before the Judge in said
Court; that said charge was, in fact, false and the plaintiff, on
the trial thereof at said Criminal Court, was acquitted and dis-
charged; that the defendants made the said charge from motives
of malice; that there was no reasonable or probable cause for
said prosecution; that the plaintiff's reputation was injured
thereby and she has lost the society and hospitality of her
friends and associates and that she was forced to spend divers
sums of money in conducting her defense.

WHEREFORE suit is brought and the plaintiff claims
\$5,000 damages.
