

And the Jurors aforesaid, upon their oath aforesaid, do further present that the said BERNARD MOORE on the said day in the said year, at the City aforesaid, unlawfully did carry and wear openly with the intention and purpose of injuring a certain person whose name is to the jurors aforesaid unknown, a certain dangerous and deadly weapon, to wit: a razor contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided, and against the peace, government and dignity of the State.

THIRD COUNT.

And the Jurors aforesaid, upon their oath aforesaid, do further present that the said _____ on the said day in the said year, at the City aforesaid, unlawfully did carry and wear openly with the intention and purpose of injuring a certain person, to wit: _____ a certain dangerous and deadly weapon, to wit: _____ contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided, and against the peace, government and dignity of the State.
