




hereinafter called the "Owners," do hereby offer to pay the H. B. Hull and Co
of the City of Baltimore State Md hereinafter called the "Contractor," for the

materials contained in the specifications and schedule hereinafter listed, the full and just sum of Three hundred & thirty five ⁵⁰/₁₀₀
Dollars (\$ 335.50), as follows: _____ Dollars (\$ _____) on satisfactory

delivery by the Contractor of the material, and the balance, \$ _____ in 8 equal monthly payments on 25 day
of each consecutive month thereafter until the whole amount has been paid in cash. Date of purchase of property 1921

Failure to meet any payment when due shall render all other payments hereunder due and immediately payable.

And the Owner does hereby agree that the Contractor, his, their or its assigns, may enter a judgment by confession at any time prior to the pay-
ment of the full balance due under this contract for the amount then due, and I (we) do hereby empower any attorney at law to appear for me (us) in
any court of record or before any justice of the peace, with or without declaration filed, and confess judgment against me (us) in favor of the holder of
this contract for the amount due thereon; and, in the event of default in the payments due hereunder as and when due, I (we) agree to pay all costs of
suit in securing said judgment and execution thereon and attorney's fee of 15 per cent for collection. The Owner hereby waives stay of execution and the
benefit of all homestead and other exemption laws now in force or hereafter passed.

Title to any equipment, appliance, materials or supplies of any kind or character furnished by the Contractor herein shall remain in said Con-
tractor, his, their or its assigns, until payment therefor has been made in full in cash, and in case of default in payment the Contractor may enter the
premises and remove said equipment, appliance, materials or supplies without legal process.

And the Owner agrees that any extension or alteration in the terms of payment or the amounts due hereunder shall not be a waiver of any rights
of the Contractor, his, their or its assigns.

This offer does not bind the Contractor until it is accepted by the Contractor. When accepted, the Contractor is bound to furnish the labor and
materials specified in strict accordance with schedule.


