COMMITMENT TO HOUSE OF CORRECTION.

STATE OF MARYLAND, TALBOT COUNTY, SCT.

TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE MARYLAND HOUSE OF CORRECTION, GREETING:

WHEREAS, George H. Palmer-----was brought before me a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland in and for the County aforesaid and Police Justice in and for St. Michaels District thereof, charged on the oath of Albert Wrightson-----with the offense of Assault and battery on him the-----said Albert Wrightson on farm in St. Michaels District, Talbot County Maryland on May 31st. 1919-----

and after having been infremed by me of his right to have a trial by jury of said charge, and having thereupon declared that he wished to waive his said right and abide by the determination of said charge by me was thereupon on this 31st-----day of May-----A.D. 1919, tried before me and pleaded guilty of said offense after hearing evidence and sentenced to be confined in the Maryland House of Correction for a period of Twelve months-----from this date May 31st. 1919-----

This is therefore to command you to receive the said Geo. H. Palmer-----into your custody in the Maryland House of Correction there to imprison him for the space of Twelve months-----from this date. May 31st 1919-----or he be discharged in due course of law, and for so doing this shall be your sufficient warrant.
