And the plaintiff was for a long time deprived of the services and society of her child, and was forced to and did spend divers sums of money for medical attention and medicine in attempting to cure the said Bertha Proctor , infant of her hurts and wounds occasioned as aforesaid.

And the plaintiff says that her damages were caused by the negligence and want of due care on the part of the defendant and that Bertha Proctor, infant, in no wise contributed thereto.

Wherefore the plaintiff claims \$5,000.00 damages.
