To the Superintendent of the Md. House of Correction Greeting:

Whereas Robert Reines was brought before me, a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland, in and for the county aforesaid, charged on the oath of Lee Nicholson and other witnesses with obtaining money under false pretence at Laurel Park race tract on 17th day of October in the 4th district of Anne Arundel County, 1921.

and upon being informed by me of his right to have a trial by Jury of the said charge, thereupon declared that he wishes to waive his said right and abide by the determination of said charge by me; and thereupon, trial of the said charge having been had before me, on the 18th day of October 1921, ~~of~~ the said Robert Reines was on last mentioned day, duly adjudged by me guilty of the said charge, and was on said day committed by me to the Md. House of Correction for two years.

NOW, THEREFORE, you are hereby commanded to receive from any officer the body of the said Robert Reins and him safely keep in the said Md. House of Correction until he shall thence be delivered according to law. Hereof fail not at your peril.
