TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Your Oratrix complaining respectfully represents:

- (d) That she may have such other and further relief as her case may require.

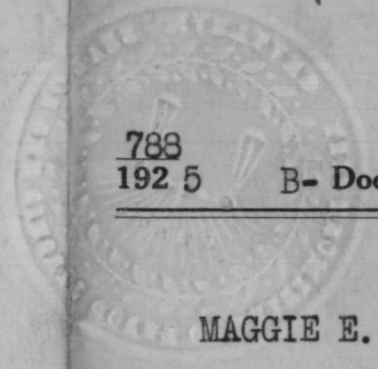
