Steward Davis sues the Mary Magdalene Court No. 23 Grand United Order of Nazarites, a corporation of the State of Maryland, for that Ida Fields, presiding officer of said defendant, Laura Parker a member of said defendant corporation and divers other members, on or before February 22nd 1916, while in exercise of the corporation duties did wrongfully enter the home of the plaintiffs, while the Victoria Scott was lying in bed critically ill; that the said Ida Fields, Laura Parker and divers others did further wrongfully rush up the stairs of said plaintiffs' house and noisily and suddenly rush into the sick room of said Victoria Scott and then frighten her so that it was necessary for a physician to be in constant attendance of her bedside for several hours and that her illness was aggravated by the fright so that she was compelled to remain in her bed for several weeks longer than her normal illness would have required; that the said Victoria Scott was suffering at the time with an affection of the heart which was aggravated by the sudden and threatening crowding of such a large number of persons so unexpectedly into her sick room; that the said Victoria Scott and her husband suffered great pecuniary loss and damage.

The plaintiffs claim twenty-five hundred dollars damage, (\$2500.00).
