James Smith, plaintiff by Davis and Evans, his attorneys,
sues William Brown, defendant.

For that on or about the 6th day of February, 1926, while the plaintiff was legally crossing a public highway of Baltimore City at or near the intersection of Presstman and Division streets, both public highways of Baltimore City, he was struck by an automobile owned and operated by William Brown, who was then and there operating the same along and upon one of the above mentioned highways in a reckless manner. And as a result of having been struck as aforesaid the plaintiff was thrown down and against the street with great force and violence and he was seriously and permanently injured about the head, limbs and body, and he became and was sick, sore, lame and disordered and so remained for a long time, to wit:- from thence, hitherto; during all of which time the plaintiff was forced to and did spend large sums of money in attempting to cure himself of his hurts and wounds occasioned as aforesaid and was prevented from performing his usual occupation.

And the plaintiff says that all of his aforesaid injuries and damages were caused by the carelessness, negligence and want of due care on the part of the defendant and that he in no wise contributed thereto.

WHEREFORE suit is brought and the plaintiff claims \$5000.00 damages.
