Lizzie Smothers by her attorneys, Davis and Evans sues the Star Life Insurance Company, a body corporate.

I. For that on or about the *20* day of *July, 1925* the defendant was a corporation, incorporated with authority to utter insurance upon lives within the State of Maryland; that on the *20* day of *July 1925* aforesaid, in consideration of the payment by one William Whittington, late of Baltimore City deceased, of a premium of *20* — cents and like sum to be paid by him weekly during his life, the defendant made its policy of insurance in writing, agreeing to pay upon the death of the said William Whittington, upon surrender of policy and evidence of premium payment and proof of death, the sum of one hundred and forty (\$140) dollars to Lizzie Smothers.

2. That on the 9th day of December, 1926, the said William Whittington died and his death was not caused by any of the causes exempted in said policy. That the said William Whittington deceased, fulfilled all the conditions of said insurance on his part in his lifetime, that the plaintiff has made due proof of death of William Whittington, that she has surrendered the policy and book showing receipt of premium payments, in accordance with requirements of said policy; that the defendant refused to pay the amount of the claim though demand has been frequently made.

WHEREFORE the plaintiff claims \$200.00
