TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

The bill of complaint of Bessie Walker respectfully shows:

FIRST: That she was married to the defendant on the 4th day of May, 1916, at Virginia.

SECOND: That she has resided in the State of Maryland, for more than two years before the filing of this suit, and is now a resident of Baltimore City in said state.

THIRD: That the defendant did illtreat and abuse your oratrix and refuses to properly support her.

FOURTH: That the defendant without just cause or provocation abandoned and deserted your oratrix at Baltimore City, on Jan. 1st, 1919; that said abandonment has continued uninterruptedly for more than three years, is deliberate and final and the separation of the parties beyond any reasonable expectation of reconciliation.

FIFTH: That the defendant is employed as a teamster and earns approximately about twenty-five dollars per week.

SIXTH: That your oratrix is in destitute circumstances and unable to support herself or employ counsel to prosecute this suit.

YOUR ORATRIX PRAYS:

(1) That she may be divorced a vinculo matrimonii from the defendant.

(2) That she may be allowed alimony pendente lite and permanent, also counsel fees for her attorney.

(3) That she may have such other and further relief as may appear proper and just.

(4) That subpoena issue directed to the said defendant, David Walker, who resides at 700 Ensor Street, Baltimore.
