CONVICTION COMMITMENT.

STATE OF MARYLAND, WASHINGTON COUNTY, to-wit:

To the Superintendent of the Maryland House of Correction:

WHEREAS, Frank Welcham of Washington County aforesaid, was brought before me, the subscriber, a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland, in and for Washington County on this 15 day of February A. D. 1921, charged with committing a nuisance in that the said Frank Welcham indecently exposed his person in public view on the alley leading from West Franklin St to West Washington St - the southern end being opp. Prospect St. in Hagerstown, Maryland a public alley or highway contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided and against the peace, government and dignity of the State, on the 14 day of February A. D. 1921, at Washington County aforesaid, and whereas he the said Frank Welcham was informed of his right to trial by jury thereupon freely elected to be tried before me, waiving his right to a jury trial, he was thereupon tried by me and convicted of said offense and sentenced to two years in the Maryland House of Correction

I do therefore, by virtue of the Acts of Assembly in such case made and provided, command you to receive the said Frank Welcham into your custody in the Maryland House of Correction there to imprison him for the term of two years from this date and for so doing this shall be your sufficient warrant.
