WHEREAS, Frank Welcham of Washington County aforessid, was brought before me, the subscriber, a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland, in and for Washington County on this 15 day of February A. D. 1921, charged with committing a nuisance in that the said Frank Welcham indecently exposed his person in public view on the alley leading from West Franklin St to West Washington St - the southern end being opp. Prospect St. in Hagerstown, Maryland a public alley or highway contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided and against the peace, government and dignity of the State, on the 14 day of February A.
