Davie Wellons, plaintiff by Davis and Evans, his attorneys, sues George Gardner:

1. For that whereas, the plaintiff to wit; on the 22nd day of August, 1924 was working on Liberty Heights Avenue in Baltimore City, State of Maryland. The defendant was then and there operating an automobile along and upon said Liberty Heights Ave. at or near to the place where the plaintiff was working, and the defendant did then and there so carelessly and negligently operate said automobile, that said automobile ran into and struck against the plaintiff's wheel-barrow with great force and violence and the plaintiff was then and there thrown down unto and against the said street, and he then and there became and was sick, sore and lame and disordered as a result thereof and so remained for a long time, during all of which time he was prevented from performing his ordinary affairs and receiving the emoluments therefrom, and the plaintiff was forced to and did spend divers sums of money in attempting to cure himself of his hurts and wounds.

2 And the plaintiff says that all of his aforesaid injuries and damages were occasioned by the negligence of the defendant and that he in no wise contributed thereto.

Wherefore the plaintiff claims \$1,000.00 damages.
