The judgment is vacated and the case is remanded to the Court of Appeals of Maryland for consideration in light of [Griffin v. Maryland, 378 U.S. 130, 84 S.Ct. 1770](#), and [Bell v. Maryland, 378 U.S. 226, 84 S.Ct. 1814](#).

Mr. Justice DOUGLAS would reverse outright on the basis of the views expressed in his opinion in [Bell v. Maryland, 378 U.S. 242, 84 S.Ct. 1823](#).

Mr. Justice BLACK, Mr. Justice HARLAN and Mr. Justice WHITE dissent.
