# Md. store lowers bar

BALTIMORE

A department store lowered the barrier in its main dining room Saturday after some 200 Morgan State College students arrived to set up picket lines in the downtown area.

A small group of students entered the dining room at the Hochschild - Kohn department store around noon and were served immediately.

Three other stores refused to accommodate the students.

Shortly after the pickets arrived downtown, dining areas at the Hecht-May Company, Stewarts and Hutzlers were closed.

Picket lines consisting of 20 persons each were thrown up around the three stores.

A COURT injunction was issued on Friday limiting the activities of 14 Morgan students at a department store outlet in a shopping center.
