Extract from Regulations of the Board of Health to secure a full and correct Vital Statistics in the City of Baltimore.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted and ordained, That whenever any person shall die in the said City of Baltimore, the Physician who attended during his or her last sickness, or the Coroner, when the case comes within forty-eight hours after the death, to the Undertaker or other persons superintending the burial, as far as the same can be ascertained, the full name, sex, age and condition (whether married or single) of the deceased, and date of death, except in cases of births and deaths of illegitimate children.
