

# GOVERNORS WILL MEET TODAY

## Harrington To Be Host At Reception Tonight.

Annapolis, Md., Dec. 15.—With the readjustment policies as the chief topic according to the program, the tenth annual Conference of State Governors will begin at Annapolis tomorrow morning to continue three days. Executives of nearly 40 states will assemble here for the conference and added importance is given through the fact that several members of President Wilson's Cabinet will speak.

The sessions will be held at the State House. Governor Harrington will deliver the address of welcome at the initial meeting at 11 o'clock tomorrow morning. The response will be by Governor Manning, of South Carolina. Governor Harrington will give a reception at the Executive Mansion tomorrow night.

The Cabinet officials who are expected to address the conference are: Secretary of the Navy Daniels, Secretary of War Baker, Secretary of Agriculture Houston, Secretary of the Interior Lane and Secretary of Labor Wilson.

The first of the Governors to reach the city were Ramberger, of Utah, and Burnquist, of Minnesota. They arrived today and are staying at Carvel Hall, which will be the headquarters of the Executives.
