25 } declaring Maryland's
Public Training Schools are part of the public
education system, further declaring that those
parts of Sections 657 and 659-661 of Article 27
of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1957 Edition,
which requires separation of Negro and White
races in the four training schools violate both
the equal rights and the due process clauses of
the Fourteenth Amendment of the Constitution of
the United States, and are unconstitutional,
further declaring that the Court cannot select a
Training School to which a minor is to be
committed on the basis of the minor's race or
color; and further, forever and permanently
enjoining and restraining Defendants, +c. from
denying to Plaintiff and other Negro youths,
solely on account of race and color, commitment,
admission and transfer to any Training
School established, operated and maintained
by the State of Maryland, Defendants to pay
costs (25) fd.
