

DAILY SESSIONS OF COUNCIL

To Pass Segregation Ordinance Is Plan Of Leaders.

When the City Council meets this afternoon it is expected that the new race segregation ordinance will be presented, and a determined effort will be made to have the Council hold daily sessions until the measure is passed. Councilmen Tolson, of the Sixteenth ward; Stockham, of the Eighth, and others are prepared to take the lead in demanding this.

Mr. Stockham is incensed over the fact that houses on East North avenue, in his ward, have been offered for rent to colored tenants, and the invasion of white blocks in the Sixteenth ward by negroes has stirred up Mr. Tolson. Councilman West, of the Thirteenth ward, is one of the original fighters against such invasions, and it was his ordinance that was declared invalid by the Court of Appeals.

City Solicitor Field has been at work on the new measure that is to be taken up as the administration ordinance. It will be advocated by a large number of property owners who are expected to attend the Council session this evening.
